

During Holy Week, a number of us met for a Parish Prayer Meeting, focusing on praying for peace. If you don't usually attend prayer meetings, I would really encourage you to do so – praying together is powerful and encouraging, and something that we should all be prioritising.

But for me, the timing of this meeting was also very poignant, as we approached the events of Easter weekend. From the betrayal, friend turning on friend, we see on Maundy Thursday, to the pain and death of Good Friday. We see these reflected in conflicts across the world today. For many of us, watching those events feels like the in-between of Holy Saturday. The mourning, the confusion, the uncertainty. The knowledge that one day there will be no more war, but we are not there yet.

But we also look to Easter Sunday – our reminder that from death can come a miracle. That all things are possible. That God's power knows no bounds. If he can raise from the dead, then surely he can raise peace and unity from even the darkest of situations.

So, as we remember the events of Easter - I encourage you to continue praying for peace. For Ukraine and Russia, Gaza and Israel, Haiti, Sudan, Myanmar, Ethiopia, and many other places around the world.
