


ST PETER'S CHURCH OLD WOKING

Introduction

Leader We have come together in the name of Christ to offer our praise and thanksgiving, to hear and receive God's holy word, to pray for the needs of the world, and to seek the forgiveness of our sins, that by the power of the Holy Spirit we may give ourselves to the service of God. <u>Confession</u> (Please sit or kneel) An introduction to the confession may be said

All Lord God, we have sinned against you; we have done evil in your sight. We are sorry and repent. Have mercy on us according to your love. Wash away our wrongdoing and cleanse us from our sin. Renew a right spirit within us and restore to us the joy of your salvation, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen

<u>Collect</u> (special prayer for today)

Absolution (we are reminded that God forgives all who repent)

- Leader May the Father of all mercies cleanse *us* from *our* sins, and restore *us* in his image to the praise and glory of his name, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**.
- Leader Blessed is the Lord,
- All For he has heard the voice of our prayer;
- Leader Therefore shall our hearts dance for joy!
- All And in our song will we praise our God.
- Prayer of Thanksgiving
- Leader We thank you, O God, for you are gracious. You have loved us from the beginning of time and you remember us in times of trouble and of joy.
- All Your mercy endures for ever
- Leader We thank you, O God, for you came to us in Jesus Christ, who has redeemed the world and saves us from our sins.
- All Your mercy endures for ever
- Leader We thank you, O God, for you have sent your Holy Spirit, who comforts us and leads us into all truth.
- All Your mercy endures forever. Amen

Leader As we rejoice in the gift of this new day, so may the light of your presence, O God, set our hearts on fire with love for you; now and for ever. **Amen.**



THE WORD OF GOD


A psalm may be included here or between the readings and may end with:
