Shining Out into our communities through new projects like the Community Fridge, Community Garden, and Refresh Extra for teenagers

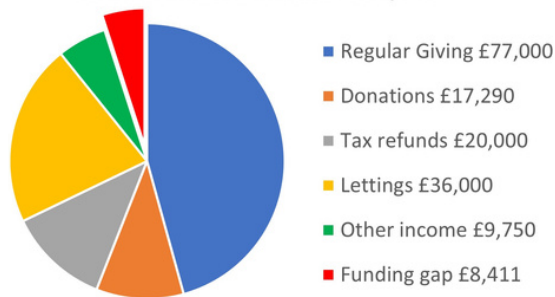
Guiding In through the Bible & Romans courses, confirmations, Connections Cafe and Communion classes for children

Welcoming Home regularly at our services, connect groups, Sunday school and youth group.



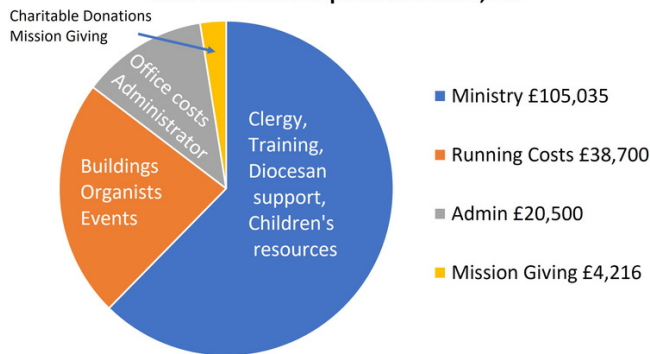

The PCC maximises our income revenues wherever possible and plans our spending carefully. However, our **regular giving has decreased**, leaving us with a projected deficit of £8,500 in 2025. We are asking people to increase their regular giving, or start giving regularly, so we can plan for more mission in 2026.

2025 Estimated Expenditure £168,451



If we increase our regular giving, by

10% we will break even and have the funding to apply for a new curate for 2027

25% we can apply for a curate *and* could consider employing a part-time community/families worker
