# VICAR'S VIEW

I was interested to hear a friend with whom I play football is not a churchgoer ask another friend what he was giving up for Lent, assuming that everyone did (though my other friend doesn't and quipped 'I'm giving up giving up things!'). Abstinence is still seen as a good thing with initiatives like 'Dry January' very popular at present, though of course we all find it hard. At the youth group L8 last Sunday we gave out 'Love Life Live Lent' booklets with suggestions for each day of Lent on either giving something up or doing something positive and the young people were horrified at the idea of giving up screens (phones, tablets, TVs, computers etc) for a day, though some warmed to the challenge later. I hope everyone is marking Lent in some special way, whether through abstinence or doing something positive, because it helps us appreciate what we take for granted, is good for the soul and, for 40 days at least, enables us to imitate Jesus in a small way.
