WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY AUDIT?

On this Day of Pentecost, as a church at the heart of its community, we yearn for God's Spirit to reveal his power to work mightily in our churches across this parish; and for his presence to stir us up, revive us, and quicken us to become mighty witnesses and evangelists for him.

Our Community Audit, which starts today with a questionnaire to the congregation (Stage 1), is a threefold information gathering exercise to gain a 'picture' of the needs of the local community. Stage 2 involves the wider community; and Stage 3 involves local organisations. The overall purpose is to help the church to better understand the community that it serves and shape its mission action plans for the future.

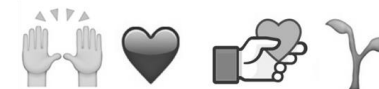
