Refreshments will be served after the service. If you know of a friend whom you think would find it helpful then please invite them. Flyers will be available in each church next week.



RACHEL'S RAMBLINGS

Last Wednesday was World Mental Health Day. Sadly, each year 1 in 4 people suffer from a mental health issue but there is still tremendous stigma around it, and this can be particularly the case in church, where mental health issues may be perceived as spiritual weakness.
