MICK'S MUSINGS

When you've been around for a number of years there doesn't seem much about the meaning of Christmas that you haven't heard before. But I haven't heard much about the cost of Christmas, I don't mean the money spent on presents and food, but the cost to God. This was brought home to me as I read the carol "What kind of greatness can this be?" One of the effects of the stroke I suffered was that I lost the ability to walk. One of the major frustrations I had in the hospital was that the toilet was a few yards from my bed but I couldn't walk there, I had to be taken by wheelchair. Over the past three years I have learned to walk again, after a fashion, and I long to walk normally. I certainly would not choose to have to learn to walk again. But there is a person who chose to go through this process of learning again. It is Jesus, whose coming as a tiny babe we remember and celebrate. As the hymn writer puts it poetically:

The one who strode among the stars and called each one by name lies helpless in his mother's arms and must learn to walk again.

The cost of Christmas is immeasurable and it is not measured in money, pounds and pence, but in love. The creator becoming a creature. As another hymn writer puts it:

Thou who wast rich beyond all splendour,

all for love's sake becamest poor,

thrones for a manger didst surrender,

sapphire-paved courts for stable floor.

Thou who wast rich beyond all splendour,

all for love's sake becamest poor.
