

I know many of you have really enjoyed our online services and I would like to say a huge thank you to the team of Sam, Rachel and especially



Robin, our technical whizz, who plan and put these services together so creatively, as well as to the many of you who have contributed with your readings, prayers, videos and pictures.

But great though these services are, and lovely for many who can watch in your pyiamas, or at a time convenient to you and who no longer have to come to church early to be on duty, I'm aware that it is not the same as worshipping God together in person, sharing fellowship and celebrating communion. I'm also aware that many are unable to join us in our online services, though hope that through receiving the full order of service you can participate in your own way.

We await a date when we are allowed to worship together again and then guidance on how many can gather, whether we can sing or not, celebrate communion in some way and so on.
