* UPDATE ON CHERITH WITHINGTON – MISSION PARTNER *

Cherith is one of our mission partners working with Church Army as an evangelist in Liverpool. It's been very encouraging to hear that in spite of Covid-19 and all the restrictions it has brought about on gatherings, Cherith has managed to carry on proclaiming Christ via the wonders of Zoom. In the last month alone, she has managed to lead a very successful summer play scheme that had over 50 families attend. She currently runs a Toddler Church once a week with between 15 to 20 families attending and she is still doing assemblies in at least three schools via Zoom together with other pre-recorded material that is played during these assemblies. Like many of us, she is grateful that technology has enabled mission to carry on, using it to witness and disciple God's people

She still needs our prayers and support. Prayers for among other things, more opportunities and means to minister, prayers for Liverpool as it's currently on the 'Covid watchlist'. *** OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD - SHOEBOX SUNDAY – 1 NOVEMBER 2020 ***

Hand-made or knitted stuffed toys can be included, providing they are stuffed with commercial stuffing and not, for example, old stockings or beans.**

Each online shoebox costs £20, which includes the £5 for shipping and distribution costs.

*** VICAR'S VIEW**

Another week, another major government announcement on changes to restrictions, this time restricting opening hours of bars and restaurants and encouraging people to work from home again. It doesn't look as if it will affect our services in church for the time being but on top of the 'Rule of Six' introduced last week it will clearly affect the day to day lives of many and threaten a number of jobs.

It feels like a large step backwards, after the easing of restrictions over the summer, but with the number of Coronavirus cases increasing rapidly again the government clearly felt they had to act decisively.

Reading Psalm 30 this week I was struck by verse 5 – "For his anger lasts only a moment, but his favour lasts a lifetime; weeping may remain for a night, but rejoicing comes in the morning." This pandemic is lasting much longer than most of us thought and hoped and will clearly affect us significantly for some time to come. But in God's eyes it is just a moment (and I'm not suggesting that the pandemic has happened because of God's anger!) and whilst not trying to minimise the effect it has on us, especially for many young people whose life is on hold, it will not last for ever. The morning will come when there will be the rejoicing that we usually enjoy and the most important thing is to know God's favour – his presence with us – which lasts a lifetime and strengthens us through these uncertain times.

God calls us to persevere, as people throughout history have done through war, famine and persecution and to seek his presence with us and enjoy his everlasting favour.

* COVID-19 RULE OF SIX *

This is the new 'Rule of Six', which we thought would be helpful for everyone to know,

In England, the limit of up to six people from multiple households meeting up applies both indoors and outdoors, and to all ages.

When seeing friends and family you do not live with you should:

1. meet in groups of six or less
2. follow social distancing rules
3. limit how many different people you see socially over a short period of time
4. meet people outdoors where practical; meeting people outdoors is safer than meeting people indoors because fresh air provides better ventilation.

As well as the above, venues following COVID-19 secure guidelines will be able to continue to host more people in total - such as religious services in places of worship - but no one should mix in a group of greater than six. For more specific information please see www.gov.uk/coronavirus.
