The contractors have said they will complete their work by Good Friday, though the floor may not have dried enough to have the carpet laid by then.

We plan to hold Sunday services in St Peter's whilst the work is done, but please wrap up warm as the heating needs to be switched off. The church will be closed during the week for visitors.

Thank you to all who have given to the work. We have raised approximately £13,000 so far with another £3,000 pledged of the £22,000 needed. Gifts have been made for 18 of the 20 chairs we will be purchasing.

If you have made a pledge and can give by the end of April that would be appreciated, but any time this year is fine. We will continue to fundraise and await the outcome of grant applications and welcome any additional gifts.

*** AFFINITY WATER – OLD WOKING ROAD AT HOEBRIDGE – NEW ***

Councillor Will Forster posted on the “Nextdoor” site on Thursday that **Affinity Water has confirmed that Old Woking Road will reopen to traffic from Friday afternoon, 10 March.** This will help ease congestion in the Woking area and ensure motorists are not ‘trapped’ by road closures on Sunday when the Surrey Half Marathon place.

However, Affinity Water have said they may need to return to fix the ongoing issues on Old Woking Road in future – but those works shouldn’t involve a full road closure.

*** SUMMARY OF CHURCH COUNCIL MEETINGS – NEW ***

Our church councils from each of our three churches met last month. The main items of note were:

- At St Peter's and St Mark's we reviewed the use of individual cups for Communion and whether to return to the Common Cup, but felt it was too early to do so
- We looked at the Church Development plan for 2023 which focuses on Children and Families, Welcoming, Giving and Prayer
- At St Peter's we looked at possibilities for preserving in the short term and replacing in the medium term the windows in the Church Centre, which are in poor condition

***REVISION OF THE CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL ***

We are entering another period of revision of the Church Electoral Roll, which needs to be revised before the Annual meetings.

If you are resident in the parish or have attended public worship regularly at one of our churches in the past six months and you are baptised and aged 16 or over, you can now be added to the Electoral Roll. Fill in an application form, available in each church, sign it and return it to me or one of the churchwardens.
