"I am writing to advise you of our project to upgrade the gas network pipes in Westfield Road, Woking. We are replacing our old metal gas mains and services with new plastic pipe. This essential work will ensure your community continues to receive a safe and reliable gas supply. A new phase of work commenced on Tuesday 9 May for approximately twenty-eight weeks. Our engineers will be working from the junction of Westfield Road and Moor Lane. We will be working along the road in phases. I thought I would take this opportunity to update everyone on the Ukraine mission trips. You may have noticed that we have not been appealing for donations as much as we did when the war began. The reason for this is that we have been asked to supply more medical equipment. To this end a lot of donations have come from corporate sources, these include such things as hospital beds, operating theatre equipment, medical consumables and walking aids.

We are grateful for and continue to take your donations of clothing and medicines, which keep up the flow normal relief aid. Because of the need to transport so much extra stuff we do not need to run any appeals at the moment.

Our main need now is for money to buy fuel and ferry tickets for the vehicles. We have two more trips planned in the immediate future, trip Number 9 in June and then a big one in August when we are teaming up with some other organisations.

A BIG thank you goes to everyone who has donated to our efforts to bring practical relief to the refugees over the last twelve months.
