* GAZA - WHAT CAN WE DO? - NEW *

Further to my note last week sharing the House of Bishops' statement calling for an immediate ceasefire, here are some suggestions of what we can do. Many of us feel helpless, we don't know how to help, and we may feel nervous about how our actions could be perceived. Here are some suggestions that enable us to act positively according to our conscience:

Pray. I'm sure most of us are praying, but continue to do so, prayer makes a difference and we are encouraged to be persistent in prayer. Use the prayer below, but also pray with others. We regularly pray for the situation in Gaza in Morning Prayer and all are welcome to join (see separate note for details). We are holding a Parish Prayer meeting on Tuesday 26 March, during Holy Week, to pray especially for peace, in Gaza and the Middle East, in Ukraine and in other places that rarely get into the media. See the separate note for details.

<u>Give</u>. There are many organisations providing humanitarian aid who need money. Recommended ones are:

Learn. While the current conflict began on 7 October, many of us know that there is a long history here. Let's do our best to be informed: watch documentaries, read opinions (especially from people who live in Israel and Palestine) and make sure our conversations are based not just on what we've heard from the media and social media.

You may also wish to join the peace marches in London or join in with local groups. Do talk about it with others: we may hold different views in our churches, so be aware and sensitive, but we shouldn't stay silent on important matters.
