Sarah's focus is on running a theological college which trains local church leaders, and Simon works with the Diocese of Northern Uganda on different projects. Recently, Simon worked on a 'Rooted in Jesus' resource – a course that was translated into many different languages to equip local churches to reach out to their communities. He is now helping the diocese to plant soya, coffee, cocoa and bananas over fifteen acres of diocesan land as a way of helping their financial stability. However, with the lack of capital funds to buy machinery, this will all be done by hand – do pray for them as you plant seeds of your own this spring!
