

As we approach St George's Day I've been thinking about courage. The legend of St George tells us that George had the courage to face a dragon, whilst history tells us that George, a soldier in the Roman army, had the courage to face death rather than deny his Christian faith – a courage shown by many of the apostles.

But Thomas, famously known as doubting Thomas, shows a different kind of courage – the courage to disagree with his friends and express his doubts and fears. Through doing so he has a very powerful encounter with the risen Jesus. I'm sure many of us can relate to Thomas – after all, we haven't seen Jesus in the flesh and we have many questions about God – but facing up to our doubts and questions can be the starting point to a deeper relationship with God.
