**\* PUBLIC LECTURE – The man who built Surrey's Churches \*  
The architect Henry Woodyer Revealed**

On Saturday 23 May 2026, 10.30am–12 noon at St Andrew's Church, Grafham, Guildford GU5 0LJ, architectural historian Robin Stannard explores the life and legacy of Henry Woodyer (1816–1896), the prolific Victorian Gothic Revival architect responsible for around 300 buildings, including many of Surrey's finest churches.

Held at Woodyer's own church ahead of its much needed restoration, the lecture will reveal the story behind its creation and the hidden splendour of its interior decoration.
