*** REVISED SERVICE PATTERN ***

Thank you to all those who responded to our revised service pattern note. Having listened and prayed we have decided to implement the new pattern from 5 July with one main change to the proposal – there will now be a service at All Souls' every Sunday for at least a trial basis until the end of 2026, details of which will be finalised at All Souls' DCC on 9 June. So the key changes are:

- ◆ Evening service at St Peter's will only be on 2nd and 5th Sundays
 - ◆ St Peter's morning services will start at 9.30am
 - ◆ St Mark's morning services will start at 11.15am
 - ◆ Energise will move to 4.00pm at St Mark's on 4th Sunday of the month
- We will be reminding everyone of the changes over the month prior to them starting on 5 July
