St Peter's Church will be opening its doors on Saturday 19 September from 11.00am to 3.00pm for an afternoon celebrating the history, heritage and hidden stories of one of Surrey's oldest churches. Majesty & Mysteries invites visitors to step inside this remarkable historic church, uncover the fascinating people, events and legends that have shaped it over the centuries. Through engaging talks and displays, you'll discover stories rarely told—including the intriguing mystery of why one person was buried at midnight. Throughout the day, St Peter's team of bell ringers will be demonstrating the ancient art of change ringing, and visitors will have the opportunity to learn more about this unique tradition—and even have a go themselves under expert supervision. There will also be brass rubbing and a children's quiz. Tea, coffee and homemade cakes will also be available, and admission is free!
