*** "BEYOND THE FACE: SEEING AND BEING SEEN IN PORTRAITS" –
TUESDAY 29 SEPTEMBER 10AM-3.30PM ST COLUMBA'S - NEW ***

The Revd Stephen Girling (Vicar of Thorpe Parish) authored 'Beyond the Face' a book in which he explores how (with proper intent), portraits of the human face can be a window into the soul of the subject.
